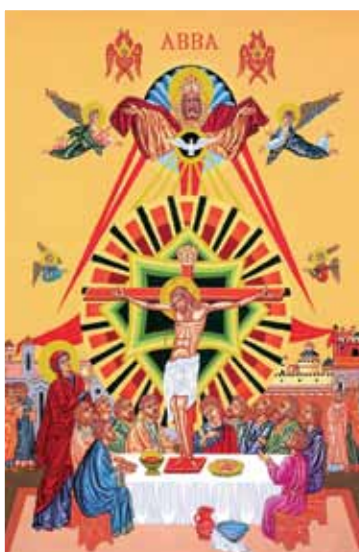

On Friday evening, Francis Cardinal George, O.M.I., Archbishop of Chicago, will deliver the keynote address, “The Liturgical Theology of Pope Benedict XVI.”

Before His Eminence’s talk, the 2012 IRL National Meeting will begin with a Solemn High Mass in the Extraordinary Form at 4 P.M. It will be celebrated by Very Rev. Cassian Folsom, O.S.B., assisted by the Canons Regular of St. John Cantius.

After the award ceremony, Father Cassian will offer a reflection on “The Inseparable Link Between Holiness and Worship.”

**Scheduled Speakers:**



**Rt. Rev. Marcel Rooney, O.S.B.**, holds a doctorate in liturgical theology and has served as an adviser to the U.S. Bishops’ Committee on Liturgy, a professor of liturgy in the Pontifical Institute of Liturgy at *Santi’ Anselmo* in Rome, and the eighth Abbot Primate of the entire Benedictine Order.



**Rev. Douglas Martis** is the Director of the LITURGICAL INSTITUTE and Chair of the Worship Department at Mundelein Seminary. He holds doctorates in sacramental theology from the *Institut Catholique* in Paris and in history of religions and religious anthropology from the University of Paris.



**Dr. Denis McNamara** is the Assistant Director of the LITURGICAL INSTITUTE where he teaches courses on liturgical art and architecture, aesthetics, the Liturgical Movement and inculturation. He holds a doctorate in architectural history from the University of Virginia.



**Sr. Maria Stella Whittier, C.J.D.**, is a member of the Sisters in Jesus the Lord, who serve the Church through promoting the Sacred Liturgy and music, as well as pro-life and missionary activity. Sister has a master’s in sacred music from Emory University and a master’s in Catholic studies from the University of St. Thomas.



**Msgr. R. Michael Schmitz** received his doctorate in dogmatic theology from the Gregorian in Rome, and holds a licentiate in canon law from Ludwig-Maximilian University. He is the Vicar General and Provincial Superior of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest in the United States.



**Rev. James Kubicki, S.J.**, is the National Director of the Apostleship of Prayer and a popular conference speaker, retreat director, and parish mission speaker. His expertise includes the Eucharist, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Spiritual Exercises, and the practical spirituality of the Apostleship.



**Dr. Scott Hahn** is a professor of theology and Scripture at Franciscan University of Steubenville, and President of the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology. A convert to Catholicism, Dr. Hahn writes extensively on Catholic issues and gives talks all over the world.



**Very Rev. Cassian Folsom, O.S.B.**, is a monk of St. Meinrad Archabbey, and professor of liturgy at the Pontifical Liturgical Institute in Rome, where he served as Pro-President from 1997-2000. He is the founding prior of the *Monastero di San Benedetto*, a new Benedictine monastery in Norcia, Italy.
